

ITALIAN BANK HEADQUARTERS EMBRACES uPASS ACCESS

With the installation of uPASS Access at the new headquarters of Banca PreAlpi, a prestigious credit bank in Italy, authorized personnel now have hands-free access to different sections in the office building. A person wearing a UHF credential will be automatically identified by the uPASS Access reader at a distance of up to 2 meters.

Banca PreAlpi was looking for solutions which offer the bank's employees convenient access to specific sections inside the building as well as the private parking facility of the institute. [uPASS Access](#) readers are installed for hands-free door access and [uPASS Reach](#) readers support convenient but controlled vehicle access to the car park. ConveXS proximity readers are applied for access to traditional secured doors.

Personnel of the PreAlpi received a [UHF Combi Card](#) with UHF and MIFARE technology. This one single card allows them authorized access to doors throughout the entire premises. The Nedap readers are integrated with a Honeywell access control system which is installed by De Vido.

The security industry is increasingly recognizing the added value of long-range RFID technology for hands-free access control situations. With the release of uPASS Access early 2013, security managers now have the ability to select the best appropriate access control solution for each individual situation: highly secured doors when necessary and conveniently accessible doors if possible.
